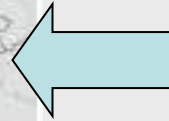

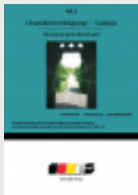

These meetings are intended for the whole family. A care of children is offered.



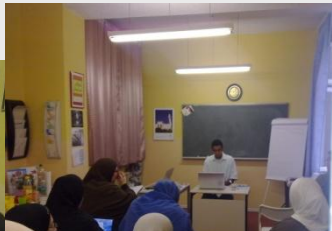
Annual meeting 2012

These are a total of 140 semestre week hours (SWH). Distributing on 7 semestres, turns out an average of 20 SWH per semestre 20 SWH means that one must study all-day:

20 hours per week would correspond lectures in the mornings; and possibly the same time again students should repeat the material and learn (i.e. the whole afternoon). With it students would have one 40-hour week what corresponds to an all-day professional employment. The literature for the whole lesson exists of publicly available books. So Students could also read the books their own. Indeed, the correspondence course is so laid out educationally that students develop a good understanding for Islam successive. The sequence of the fields should prevent that one possibly studies one-sided Islam what can have negative effects on the Islam understanding and also on own character, because one possibly gets an unbalanced personality as a Moslem. An other problem with the one-sided study of certain fields of Islam without paying attention to the character is that, that one is enticed to think, one would already know everything because one knows a lot in a small area already well.

Lesson

The participants must appropriate the lessons in the selfstudy with the help of literature given in the curriculum. Content questions can be put in the forum on www.didi-info.de.

Examination

All three months take place in cooperation with local Islamic Organisations written test at different places in the German-speaking region. In principle a written test can take place at every place if a suitable Islamic Institution volunteers to the supervision.

Public Activity

Community

In the past a social gathering for the students was offered merely by the DIdI annual meetings. Since 2011 DIdI stands up for the fact that all over Germany a community is offered for German-speaking Muslims. This should have rooted culturally and linguistically in Germany, and offer therefore a "home" above all also for ethnic German Muslims. This community should be marked by the fact that there are local communities which are maintained social and family activities as well as Islamic advanced training circles and are linked up nationally with annual meetings with each other, for example.

At the beginning of July, 2012 there was a meeting near Frankfurt with individuals and members of other Islamic German-speaking associations from the whole of Germany. These associations are also active in the German-speaking Islamic work. The meeting took place to project conceptions about a future community and carrying out from that point of view activities.
